

Preston Primary School



‘Mighty oaks from tiny acorns grow.’

Preston Primary School is at the heart of the community of Preston-on-Tees. Known locally as the ‘Village’ many of the children’s parents and grandparents also attended the school. In the Summer of 2007 we celebrated the school centenary.

Our school is part of Stockton-on-Tees Local Authority, located in the residential area of Eaglescliffe. We are two minutes away from the A66 and ten minutes from the A19. Preston Hall Museum is within walking distance and the North Yorkshire Moors and coastal areas of Teesmouth, Saltburn and Redcar are easily accessible.



Although we are 100 years old, Preston Primary School is not standing still. In 2003 a new ICT Suite and Library were added to the original building.



In January 2007 the school was further extended with a new well resourced main hall offering excellent sport and drama facilities.



We are a Group 2 school with currently 161 pupils on roll. Our admission number is 24 per year group. The school currently consists of a 26 place morning only Nursery, (p.m. Nursery to open January 2010) four mixed age classes and a Year 6 Class. The Foundation and Key Stage 1 Classes are located in classrooms separate to the main building.



The three Key Stage 2 classes are housed within the original building. An enthusiastic, committed and friendly staff work within the 6 classes. Each class has at least one Teaching Assistant or Learning Support Assistant.



The post of .5 Nursery Teacher for initially two terms has arisen because of an increase in Nursery numbers. We are looking for someone who can work well in a team and has Early Years experience.
