I have a right to be safe in this school.

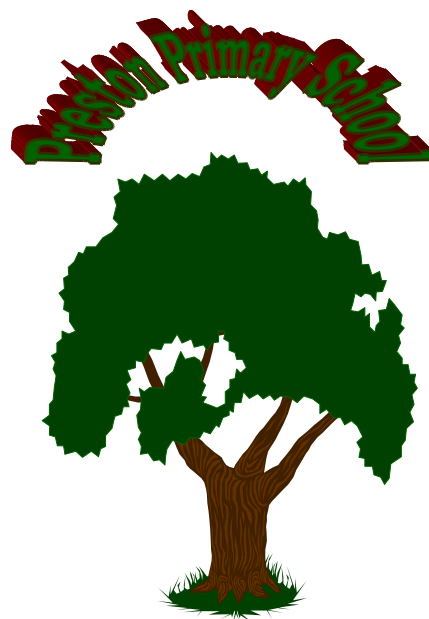
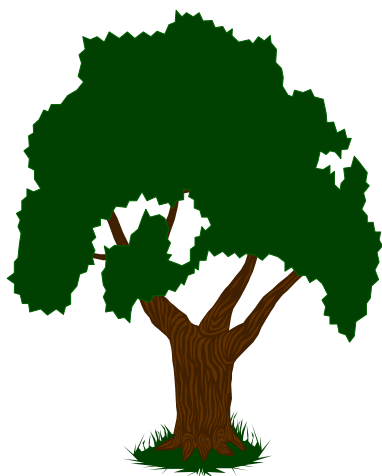
*This means that no one will hit me, kick me, push me or pinch me.*

# School Rules

## Indoor

1. We follow instructions.
2. We keep our hands, feet and objects to ourselves.
3. We do not tease or swear.
4. We ask permission to leave the room.
5. We walk when moving around the school.
6. We listen without interrupting.
7. We talk with quiet voices (no silly noises).

## Outdoor

1. We follow instructions.
2. We keep our hands, feet and objects to ourselves (no fun fighting).
3. We don't tease or swear.
4. We ask permission to cross the yellow boundary lines.

# Marbles

Each class has a jar and a box of marbles. For good deeds, good behaviour, good work etc. a child can earn a marble to be put into the jar. When the jar is full, the whole class can choose a reward.....e.g. extra playtime, a drink of juice, permission to bring a game to school etc.

# Chance Certificates

Chance Certificates will be given out each lunchtime by the "Dinner Nannies", for positive behaviour. These go into a box with the child's name written on the certificate.

During Friday's Assembly all children who have received a certificate will be recognised. Two Chance Certificates will be drawn from the box and the children may choose a reward.

# Consequences

If a child chooses not to follow the rules:

- 1 *Warning with name written down.*
- 2 *Tick next to name placed in Lunch Club for a specified time.*
- 3 *Sent to a different class.*
- 4 *Letter sent home.*

# Severe Clause

- 6 *The Head Teacher will immediately contact the parents by telephone, leading to discussion and possible exclusion from the school.*
