Light

Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.

Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object.

Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.

Rocks

Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.

Explore what is under the ground and how volcanos occur.

Maths

Recognise the value of 3 digit numbers.

Write place value related addition and subtractions eg $400 + 20 + 9 = 429$.

Locate 2 and 3 digit numbers on empty number lines.

Add and subtract using the column method.

Recall and use 2,5,10,3 and 4 times table facts.

Recognise and use fractions as numbers.
