### This Week in School

We had a visit from Galliford Try who talked to the children about their current development project at Preston Park, how to keep safe while the work is going on and the variety of jobs that there are within construction. A presentation was given by The Police School Liaison Team to children in KS2 this included internet safety and antisocial behaviour. The children engaged in question and answer sessions as well as learning how to stay safe.

Year 3 have been out on a trip this week to Darlington Library for an animation workshop. They were able to develop their skills in story boarding, character design and the use of digital tools to bring their creations to life.

### Parking

When using your car to drop off and collect children at school please be mindful of where you are parking. We have asked for parking enforcement officers to visit school to help with this.
