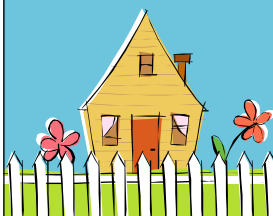


# PRESTON PRIMARY SCHOOL
